

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA

Purpose

This paper sets out the matters which should be considered at the interview of a candidate for associate membership of the Society.

Relevance

The candidate should be asked for details of:-

- engagement in an occupation or employment which share and business valuations forms a part;
- the extent of his/her personal involvement in and responsibility for share and business valuations or

The fact that share and business valuations is not a major part of the applicant's work is not a bar to associate membership.

An academic candidate should be asked to explain

- The relevance of share and business valuations to his/her academic specialisation.

Experience

There is no experience requirement for associate membership.

Professional Characteristics

There is no requirement for membership of a professional body but it would clearly be advantageous if the candidate does have such membership of a relevant professional body.

Nevertheless, it is considered that all candidates should be able to demonstrate the generally accepted characteristics of professional conduct and ethics. These should include honesty and integrity.
